Dojo for Darwin Judo Club

On television on 8 September 2015, Minister Chandler gifted a Dojo to the recently formed Darwin Judo Club. The building in question is situated on property previously owned by Corrections in Wongbilla St, Berrimah.

- 1. Does the Darwin Judo Club pay rent to the Government for the premises as the Marrara Judo Club does? If yes, how much per year? If not why not?
- 2. Does the Darwin Judo Club pay for electricity and if not, is the Government paying for electricity and how much is the amount per year?
- 3. Does the Darwin Judo Club pay for water usage and if not, is the Government paying for water usage and how much is used per year and at what cost?
- 4. If the answers to questions 2 and 3 are in the negative why then, do other youth clubs such as Girl Guides, Scouts, and the PCYC have to meet these costs and Darwin Judo Club does not?

This does not fall within the Minister for Lands and Planning portfolio and best directed to the Corrections Minister.
