## 1. What is the NTG FTE Cap for your Agency?

**ANSWER**

The NTAGO has a staffing compliment of 5 positions. Of these, three are ECO positions and two administrative positions, which are full-time. However, due to family and study needs, the Auditor-General has implemented a flexible working policy, which supports the administrative positions working on a part-time basis in non-peak times.

The nominated staffing cap for NTAGO is 4.0, which was rounded down to the nearest whole number by Cabinet.

This number is based on the following staffing arrangement which was in place at the time of the assessment of the Staffing Cap:

The administrative positions revert to their nominal full-time occupancy during peak operational times for the Agency, therefore 1) end of financial year processing (June-August) and 2) Budget processing (December-January).

Peak operating periods reflect a higher result as a consequence of all five positions operating on a full-time basis.

As the agency is small and the part-time component of the year was rounded down by Cabinet, the movement in FTE against the cap is more noticeable – even though the change is only slight.

The nominated staffing cap is 4.0 (rounded down) for NTAGO based on the following average:
