Question: How many school counsellor and school psychologist positions are currently vacant? How long have they been vacant? What are the recruitment processes?

Answer:

Three school counsellor positions, one department-based senior school counsellor position, and two department-based school psychologist positions are currently vacant, as detailed in Table 1 below.

During periods of vacancy, service delivery to schools and students is maintained by allocating referrals for service to regional/department-based school counsellors and psychologists and temporary sharing of duties between school-based counsellor positions. Schools also actively seek support from external services, for example, through local non-government organisations or health providers.
