1b The National Mental Health Commission (NMHC) Review of Mental Health Programmes and Services was commissioned by the Federal Government. It was released to the public in April this year.

Consultation on the NMHC review was conducted by the NMHC. The NMHC travelled to the Northern Territory and visited Elcho Island.

NMHC also held a two day forum in Darwin on 18 and 19 June 2015 and invited mental health stakeholders to meet with the NMHC to provide direct feedback to the Commissioners. The Chief Medical Officer was invited to meet with the NHMC and updated the Commissioners on the Northern Territory Government's mental health initiatives and provided specific feedback in relation to the NMHC review.

The Federal Government has established an Expert Reference Group to consider the findings of the review. It is expected this group will report by the end of the year.
