## **Response**

On 18 March 2020, the Minister for Health declared a public health emergency in respect of COVID-19 under section 48 of the Public and Environmental Health Act 2011 (the Act). In a public health emergency, the Chief Health Officer has broad powers under section 52 of the Act to take action considered necessary, appropriate or desirable to alleviate the public health emergency in the Territory.

The Chief Health Officer has taken considerable action to alleviate the threat of COVID-19 in the Territory, with the support of the Northern Territory Government. This has not included mandatory vaccinations, nor has it included the enactment of unconstitutional legislation or the infringement of human rights. Currently there are no mandatory vaccinations in Australia or in the NT. The NT Government does not use coercive practices to enforce any person to receive vaccinations.

The Northern Territory Government will continue to work hard to protect the people of the Northern Territory from COVID-19.
