136. Supplementary Question to Written Questions 80 and 127 - Purchase of Wheelchairs

Mr. BAILEY to MINISTER for EDUCATION and TRAINING

QUESTION

- 1. In respect of the purchase of a wheelchair on 12 February 1992 for an amount of \$6,000.00, advised in the answer to Written Question 80:
 - (a) what type of wheelchair was purchased;
 - (b) was it a "Systems 1" wheelchair; and
 - (c) if it is not a "Systems 1" wheelchair, what type is it.
- 2. Had the wheelchair been customised for a particular person; if so, for what reason.
- 3. If the answer to question 2 is yes, what was the justification for the wheelchair being purchased by the Department of Education rather than the Department of Health or a health services agency.
- 4. Is the wheelchair still owned by the Department of Education; and:
 - (a) where is it located at present;
 - (b) how long has it been at that location;
 - (c) has the wheelchair been used at its present location; and
 - (d) has it ever been used.
- 5. If the answer to question 4 is no, what are the details of its disposal, i.e.:
 - (a) to whom was it transferred; and
 - (b) for what consideration.

ANSWER

Answered on 23/12/96

1. (a) The wheelchair purchased for \$6,000 is a customised electric wheelchair used as a trial and training system.

- (b) A detachable seat from a "System 1" wheelchair was installed on a New Zealand Sedo Electric Transporter.
 - (c) The major components of this chair are a combination of two different systems.
- 2. No. The wheelchair was customised not for the use of one student, but as a trial mobility system for students with severe physical disabilities who are non-mobile and unable to propel themselves in a manual wheelchair. A variety of switches to operate the wheelchair provide a range of access options which can be trialled with individual students.
- 3. Not applicable.

 - (a) The wheelchair is based at Nemarluk School but is often on loan to students with disabilities in mainstream schools.
 - (b) The wheelchair has been based at Nemarluk School since it was purchased on 12 February 1992.
