## **Daly River Boat Ramp Tender**

On 4 June 2021, the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL) advertised a tender for the construction of a new car park and toilet facilities at the Daly River Boat Ramp off Wooliana Road. Twenty days later the tender was cancelled due to nil responses.

## **Questions:**

1. Has DIPL determined why there were nil responses to this tender?

The lack of availability of sub-contractors to install a bore, and block layers.

2. Is DIPL communicating with industry to understand the issues and make changes to ensure industry has the confidence to bid on all Government tenders?

Yes

3. When will this tender be re-advertised?

The bore installation has been awarded to Mugavins and will commence in late November 2021.

The car park works tender will be released in Q1 2022.

4. What is your anticipated budget for these works?

The 100% design estimate is \$3.6 million. Funding is available through the recreational fishing program managed by DIPL.

5. Subject to re-advertising and awarding of tender, when do you expect these works to be completed?

Completion of the car park is scheduled for the Q4 2022.
