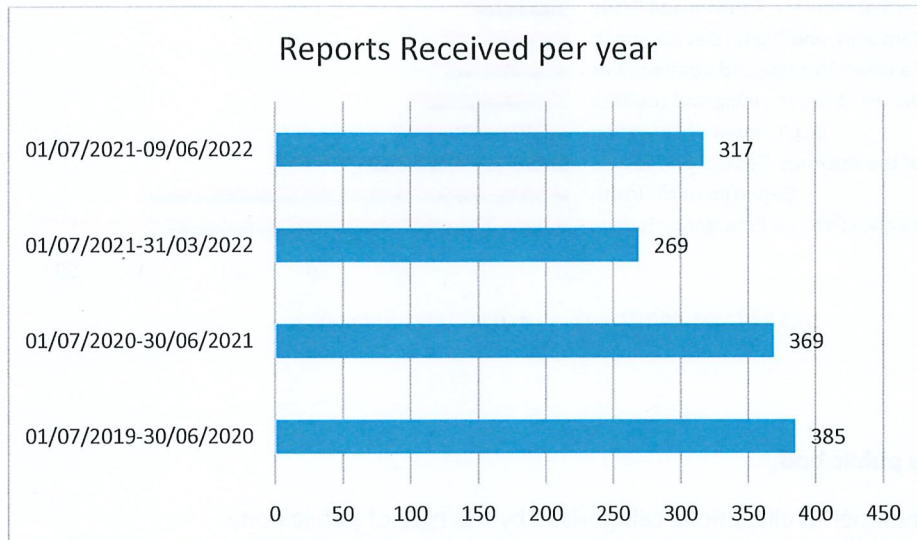

**Chart 1: Reports received by year**

Any person is entitled to make a report to the ICAC. Public officers have a mandatory obligation to make a report to the ICAC in accordance with directions issued by the Commissioner.



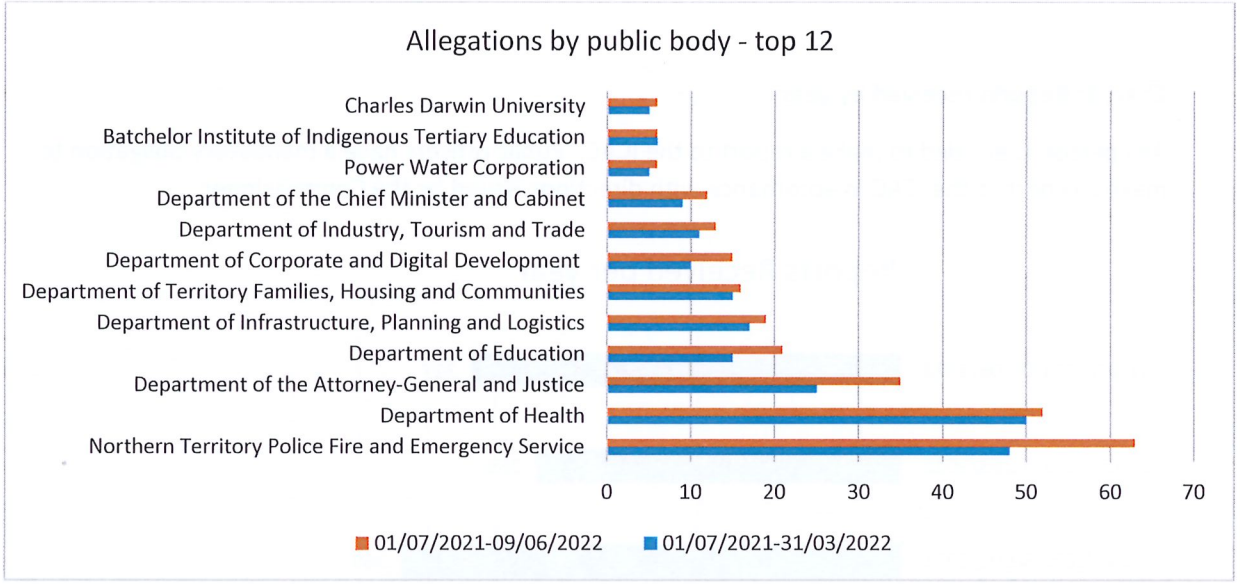
**Chart 2: Allegations received by year**

Often a report will contain more than one allegation. Each allegation is assessed on its merit.



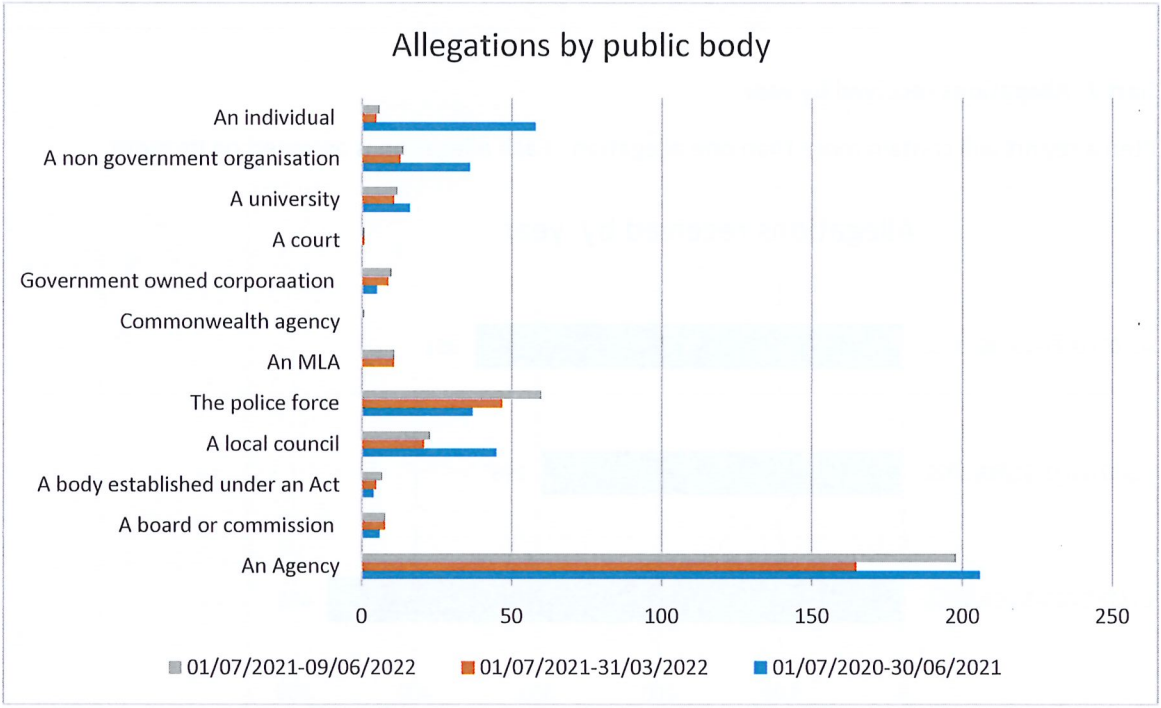
**Chart 3: Allegations by public body – top 12**

This chart sets out the 12 most common public bodies to which an allegation relates. In the vast majority of cases, the allegation does not relate to the body itself, but to the conduct of a public officer(s) within that public body.
