## Chart 1: Reports received by year

Any person is entitled to make a report to the ICAC. Public officers have a mandatory obligation to make a report to the ICAC in accordance with directions issued by the Commissioner.




Chart 2: Allegations received by year





Chart 4: Allegations by public body
