Search and Seizure Powers

Under Section 53 of the Public and Environmental Health Act 2011, authorized officers have search and seizure powers, as well as the ability to enter a place without a warrant. Recent legislative changes grant these same powers in the "post-emergency" period under Section 57G.

- 1. In the period between 23 March 2020 and 19 April 2022, how many times did an authorised officer as defined by the Public and Environmental Health Act 2011, enter a place without a warrant in accordance with Section 53? Please specify the reasons for this.
- 2. In the same period, how many times did an authorised officer as defined by the Public and Environmental Health Act 2011, search a place or seize a thing in accordance with Section 53? Please specify the reason for this.
- 3. Since 19 April 2022, how many times did an authorised officer as defined by the Public and Environmental Health Act 2011, enter a place without a warrant in accordance with Section 57G? Please specify the reasons for this.
- 4. In the same period, how many times did an authorised officer as defined by the Public and Environmental Health Act 2011, search a place or seize a thing in accordance with Section 57G? Please specify the reason for this.
