Answer: Travel costs are recorded at cost centre level, differentiated by travel destination - intra state, interstate and overseas.

Curriculum staff travel is recorded against various cost centres, and it is not possible to source the information required to answer this question accurately. Significant resources would be required to produce an indicative number only.

In relation to what can be provided, the total intrastate travel for Curriculum Services Branch, including fares, accommodation and travelling allowance to 31 May 2003 is \$291 000.

This is an increase of \$37 000 on Curriculum Services travel compared with the prior year.
