Mrs Lambley to the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics:

Alice Springs CBD Revitalisation Plan

The \$20m Alice Springs CBD Revitalisation Plan was originally announced in 2017 by then Chief Minister Michael Gunner.

1. To date how much Northern Territory Government funding has been allocated to the Alice Springs Revitalisation Plan? Please provide a breakdown of how that funding has been allocated.
2. What projects are included in the Alice Springs Revitalisation Plan? Please provide details.
3. How much funding has been allocated to each project? Please provide details.
4. What projects have been completed? Provide details of the completed projects.
5. What projects have not been completed? Provide details of the progress of the incomplete projects.
6. What is the current balance of unacquitted funds that were allocated to the Alice Springs CBD Revitalisation Plan?
7. What changes have been made to the Alice Springs CBD by the Northern Territory Government since the Revitalisation Plan was originally announced in 2017?

Response questions 1 to 7

\$15 million has been allocated for Alice Springs CBD revitalisation projects, and \$5 million towards the Breaking the Cycle of Crime plan. Further information can be found at [Alice Springs Set to Transform with Works Beginning on CBD Revitalisation | NT Rebound](#)

The first round of early works packages for the CBD Revitalisation were two new Wayfinding routes, the Heritage District and the Railway Station, with works completed August 2020. Additionally, a second early works package has included streetlights upgraded to LED luminaires in the CBD and along Barrett Drive and was completed in 2021.

There have been three main works packages tendered separately.

1. River Activation Space: Complete
2. Lighting upgrades and additional CCTV within the CBD: Anticipated completion December 2022.
3. Shade structures and landscaping in the CBD: In progress. Anticipated completion mid 2023.
