Richardson Park Revitalization Works

The commencement of the Richardson Park revitalisation works was announced on 1 March 2023. Local business DTA Contractors Pty Ltd was awarded a \$5.8 million civil works tender, with expected completion date in the first half of 2023.

Questions:

- 1. NT Government Tenders online shows the tender awarded to DTA Contractors Pty Ltd on 25 February 2022 was \$6.5 million. Why did your media release on 1 March 2022 state the amount was \$5.8 million?
- 2. Your media release of 1 March 2022 also states the total budget allocation is actually \$7.1 million. Can you also please explain this discrepancy?
- 3. On 16 February 2023, it was uncovered by the NT News that the project could be delayed by a year, because of asbestos remediation requirements. Why didn't the project scope include an allowance for asbestos on site, which would have provided for additional remediation time and cost?
- 4. Exactly how long will the asbestos remediation take? When will it commence and when will it be completed?
- 5. What is the estimated and budgeted cost for asbestos remediation?
- What impact will this asbestos remediation have on the project budget of \$7.1 million?
- 7. What will the new project completion date be?
- 8. When can Territorians expect the redeveloped Richard Park to be open?
