How many First Home Owner Grants were paid in 2001-02 and thus far in

2002-03?

Number of Grants Paid - 2001-02: No. 1637, Amount Paid \$14.2M Number of Grants Paid - 2002-03 (to 31 May 2003): No. 1107, Amount

Paid \$M\$8.3M

The drop in the number of grants in 2002-03 is partly due to the Commonwealth Government ceasing the increased first home owner grant (known as the Additional Grant) provided to first home buyers that purchase or build a new home (as opposed to an existing home). From 9 March 2001 until 31 December 2001, the Additional Grant amounted to \$7 000 (ie. Total grant of \$10 000) for the period 1 January 2002 to 30 June 2002.

Were any First Home Owner Grants made outside of the major population centres?

Yes. Indicative estimates are:

2001-02: 58

2002-03 (thus far): 42

For theses purposes, the major population centres have been assumed to be Darwin (including Palmerston), Alice Springs, Katherine, Tennant Creek and Nhulunbuy.
