Answer:

As reported in the Director-General of Licensing Annual Report 2014-2015, a 'complaint' includes only those matters that are reported in writing, are investigated and for which licensees have been asked to provide a response.

Between 1 July 2015 and 31 March 2016, 12 licences were the subject of a complaint.

An additional 3 complaints in regards to licensed premises were received between 31 March 2016 and 26 June 2016.

In the period 1 July 2015 to 26 June 2016, 15 licences were subject to a complaint. Of those:

- three were dealt with by the way of infringement notice;
- seven were dealt with by way of service with formal letters of warning served on licensees;
- one was investigated and the complaint found to be unsubstantiated by evidence;

- four complaints are currently being investigated.
