WRITTEN QUESTION

Mr Yan to the Minister for Corporate and Digital Development:

NTG Assets and Property - Criminal Damage

Note: DCDD is responsible for the management of the NT Government's leased property portfolio and does not hold information on government owned buildings.

For information related to government-owned buildings, questions are best referred to the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics.

In 2022-23 to date:

- 1. What has been the cost to assets and property due to criminal damage of non NTG assets or property?**

Costs such as these are borne by the owners of leased buildings. DCDD is not privy to nor do we have data relating to costs incurred by building owners.

- 2. How many NTG buildings/offices (owned or leased) have been subject to criminal damage?**

From 1 July 2022 to 10 April 2023, 38.

- 3. What has been the cost to NTG of repairs to buildings (owned or leased), including fencing/gates?**

DCDD does not capture or hold data relating to these costs incurred by the NT Government in either leased or owned buildings.

- 4. How many NTG buildings/offices (owned or leased) have been subject to an unlawful entry?**

From 1 July 2022 to 10 April 2023, 13.

- 5. What has been the cost to NTG for repairs and replacement of furniture and fixtures due to criminal damage?**

DCDD does not capture or hold data relating to these costs incurred by the NTG in leased or owned buildings.

These costs would ordinarily be covered by respective agencies or DIPL.

6. What have the costs been to NTG for buildings/offices (owned or leased) to improve or upgrade security measures, to reduce the incidence and likelihood of break ins and theft?

There has only been one variation to security patrol services during this period to increase the number of patrols at a site in the sum of \$1,700.

DCDD does not have visibility of costs relating to security infrastructure upgrades.
