## INQUIRY INTO A PROCESS TO REVIEW BILLS FOR THEIR IMPACT ON FIRST NATIONS TERRITORIANS CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

On 17 May 2023, the Legislative Assembly referred the matter of a *process to review Bills introduced into the Assembly for their impact on First Nations Territorians* to the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Committee for inquiry and report back to the Assembly by May 2024.

The inquiry is to consider, but not be limited to:

- The preferred body to conduct such a review, such as a statutory body composed of First Nations Territorians, or an Assembly committee advised by First Nations Territorians, and
- A requirement for a Statement of Compatibility against prescribed measures of self-determination.

To assist those interested in making a submission, the Committee has released a short discussion paper which provides an overview of the Northern Territory context and models of legislative review currently in place elsewhere in Australasia. The discussion paper also includes a number of questions relating to the main issues for consideration. The Committee invites interested people and organisations to make a submission to its inquiry responding to one or more of the questions set out in the discussion paper. Submissions are due by close of business **Friday 29 September 2023** and should be emailed to <u>LA.Committees@nt.qov.au</u>.
