No complete data exists on the tonnage of recyclable beverage containers that are disposed of in landfill before the Cash for Containers scheme commenced.

In the first quarter of the Cash for Containers schemes operation CDS Coordinators reported 584.71 tonnes of CDS material that was being recycled and not going to landfill.
