Question: Since December 2010, how many claims have now been made for

damage caused by loose stones on Tiger Brennan Drive?

Answer:

Tiger Brennan Drive opened in December 2010.

Since the new road opening, there have been 355 claims, as at 1 April 2011, for windscreen/vehicle damage as a result of loose stones. All claims relate to incidents between December 2010 and January 2011. Additional sweeping and signage installation were employed to mitigate this. The contractor engaged its insurance provider to assess the claims. Of the 355 claims:

- 143 claims have been closed out/settled:
- 37 claims have been rejected for various reasons;
- 57 claims approved where repairs are pending; and
- 118 claims are pending replies from claimants after they have been sent the claim documentation, which is needed to assess their claims.
