The Committee invites interested people and organisations to share their experiences, views and ideas on how to prevent or reduce the harms to individuals, their families and the broader community.

The Committee is holding the Public Forum to gain a broader understanding of:

- The types of support that are available to individuals and/or their families who want to address addictive behaviour or substance misuse;
- The barriers and challenges that people face in accessing support for themselves or a family member;
- Treatment approaches that have been successful;
- Reasons why people do not complete their treatment programme – and how to overcome them; and
- How to improve the availability and delivery of treatment programmes.
