# INQUIRY INTO LOCAL DECISION MAKING CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

The Public Accounts Committee is conducting an Inquiry into Local Decision Making (LDM).

Local Decision Making is a Northern Territory Government commitment to provide opportunities to transfer government service delivery to Aboriginal Territorians and organisations, based on their community aspirations.

Services delivery areas and programs can include housing; local government; education, training and jobs; health; children and families; law and justice; sports and recreation; and economic development.

The Committee is asking interested people and organisations to make a submission to the inquiry to share their views on and experience with Local Decision Making. The Committee will be focusing on:

- 1) the progress, achievements, challenges and future potential of LDM implementation across the Northern Territory.
- 2) how to foster community and leadership interest in and commitment to new LDM agreements.
- 3) the impact of technology, Treaty, Truth-Telling and Voice on LDM development.
