

Question: Northern Territory Public Sector Superannuation

- What is the date of the most recent estimate of Valuation Liabilities for Northern Territory Public Sector Superannuation as previously published in Public Accounts Committee reports.
- 2. What is the estimated amount of the Superannuation Valuation Liabilities at 30 June 1996, calculated on June 1992 prices.
- 3. Will estimates of the Valuation Liabilities for Superannuation be published in the 1993-94 Budget Papers.

ANSWER

- 1. The most recent estimate of superannuation valuation liabilities prepared by the Actuary is at 30 June 1992.
- 2. The estimated amount of superannuation valuation liabilities at 30 June 1996, calculated on June 1992 prices, is \$928.4m.
- 3. Estimates of valuation liabilities for superannuation have been provided to the Public Accounts Committee and published in the committee's 2 reports on the actual and contingent liabilities of the Northern Territory government. The actuarial review of the Northern Territory government and Public Authorities Superannuation Scheme as at 30 June 1992 was tabled in the May Sittings of the Legislative Assembly.
