The residents strongly believe that the current process underway to force residents into a shire or council is without benefits and the areas of Dundee and Marrakai wish to remain as unincorporated areas.

YOUR PETITIONERS THEREFORE HUMBLY PRAY that the Northern Territory Government does not proceed with this forced amalgamation and leaves the areas of Dundee and Marrakai as unincorporated areas as that is the wish of the residents in the two areas.

The Government has yet to receive the final report of work being done by the Coomalie Community Government Council canvassing options for inclusion of currently unincorporated areas of the Top End into a local government area.

The recommendations of the final report will be carefully considered by the Northern Territory Government, with a particular focus on the views of affected citizens.
