**Question: What is the breakdown of the tonnage of the collection of cash for containers in Darwin and Palmerston areas in comparison to other areas in the Territory?**

**Answer:**

The Darwin and Palmerston areas made up approximately 79% of the container redemptions by numbers for the January to March 2012 quarter. Collection Depots were not requested to provide redemptions of containers by weight but the 79% return rate equates to approximately 461.92 tonnes of containers returned in the Darwin and Palmerston area based on the coordinator returns for the quarter.
