Level Five Staffing

- 1. How many ministerial / political staff are employed on level 5 of Parliament House by the office of the Chief Minister?
- 2. How are these positions allocated to Ministers? Please provide a full breakdown of the staff position titles and salary levels of all staff in each ministerial office.
- 3. Please provide a full breakdown of the staff (position titles and salary levels) of all staff attached to the individual 9 Northern Territory Ministers.
- 4. How many media advisors (press secretaries or media staff) are attached to each ministerial portfolio?
- 5. How many social media staff are attached to each Minister? What salary levels are these social media staff employed on?
- 6. What is the role of the social media staff on level 5 of Parliament House?
- 7. Why do some Ministers have social media staff and other Ministers do not?
- 8. How many media advisors are employed on level 5 of Parliament House? Please provide detail of the salary levels these staff are employed on?
- 9. How many full time equivalent staff are employed at level 5 of Parliament House?
- 10. How many "executive" staff are employed at level 5 of Parliament House? Please provide a breakdown of the salary levels of all the executive staff.
- 11. How many administrative staff are employed at level 5 of Parliament House? Please provide details as to the administrative level of each staff member.
- 12. How many executive staff are employed to directly assist the Chief Minister? Please provide a breakdown of the positions titles and salary levels of these staff?

ANSWER:

As of 16 August 2022, the Office of the Chief Minister (OCM) employs 71 staff (Headcount), across nine Ministerial Offices and two shared service teams.

Generally, a Minister's Office team will consist of a Chief of Staff, Policy Advisor (1-3 Policy Advisors, depending on number of portfolios), a Press Secretary and an Executive Assistant.

The Strategic Communications and Engagement Unit is a shared service team that provides advice across OCM.

OCM employee expenses are detailed in the Department of the Chief Minister and Cabinet Annual Report. Roles range from Administrative Officer 4 to Executive Officer Contracts.
