Question: From the \$800 000 redeemed deposits returned to date, how much has been returned by clubs and pubs in comparison to mums and dads?

Answer:

The Wright Corporate Strategy (July 2009), as a preliminary assessment of the proposed Northern Territory Cash for Containers scheme, estimated CDS Containers from clubs, hotels and restaurants flowing through Depots at 5%.

Specific details on commercial returns to Collection Depots were not required to be provided to NRETAS in the first quarterly reports from scheme participants.
