Petroleum Legislation Amendment Bill 2018

Overview of the bill

This Bill, Serial 76, amends the *Petroleum Act* to provide for the consideration whether a person is an appropriate person to hold a permit or licence under the Act; provide for the review or decisions and determinations under the Act through judicial review; provide for open standing for judicial review of decisions under the Act; to empower the *Petroleum (Environment) Regulations*; and ensure the enforceability of codes of practice.
