

Did the Conservation Commission, or its agents, clear fence lines for the proposed Flora River National Park without obtaining the necessary certificates from the Aboriginal Areas Protection Authority.

ANSWER

The fencing was erected on this property by Scott Creek Station to exclude stock from the river frontage, as a stock management requirement and to prevent further erosion of the banks.

When an agreement was reached between the station and the Conservation Commission to relinquish this section of river for a nature park in the following year, the fence line was accepted as the boundary for the park.
