

TABLING NOTE FOR SUBORDINATE LEGISLATION

TOTALISATOR LICENSING AND REGULATION (WAGERING) AMENDMENT RULES 2016

Purpose

The Totalisator Licensing and Regulation (Wagering) Amendment Rules 2016 (Rules), issued by the Director-General of Licensing, relate to the operation of the Northern Territory totalisator licence.

Summary of key provisions

- The Rules lean heavily on Queensland legislation, specifically the *Wagering Rule 2010*.
- There are some exemptions to these rules and they are provided for under section 3(a) of the Rules.
- The Queensland regulator recently amended Rule 5 of the *Wagering Rule 2010* legislation which is currently an exempt rule under section 3(a).
- To allow UBET NT Pty Ltd to offer NT clients the chance to bet into international totalisator pools, it is necessary to remove Rule 5 as an exempted rule.

Note that these Rules were notified in the NT Government Gazette G10, 8 March 2017.
