### **QUESTION ON NOTICE 2.3**

How much has it cost the department or what has the cost been in terms of accidents to vehicles, particularly the 18 vehicles that the Member for Goyder had asked about, over the last 12 months.

### **ANSWER**

As advised 18 Members of the Legislative Assembly are supplied vehicles as at the date of the Estimates Hearing. However the question asked for the cost of damage to Member supplied vehicles as a result of accidents during the past 12 months. Because the number of vehicles has not been consistent at 18 over the 12 months I provide the answer based upon damage to any vehicle which was provided to a Member under their RTD entitlement during the period.

The Member for Brennan's allocated motor vehicle, a Holden Captiva was damaged on trip to Central Australia during 2010 which resulted in numerous visits to the repairers at a total cost of \$1,642.06 and while this vehicle was being repaired during 2011. The temporary replacement vehicle, a Nissan, was involved in an accident which resulted in that vehicle, with an estimated value of approximately \$19 000, being written off and sold leaving a total liability of \$4 423.05 including GST.

The Member for Daly's allocated vehicle was involved in a collision with a kangaroo resulting in damage in the sum of \$10,479.91
