NT Interpreting Service

- 1. How many Yolngu language interpreters are there in the NT Interpreting Service?
- 2. How many more Yolngu interpreters are needed to meet service needs?
- 3. How many more Indigenous interpreters are needed for language groups across the NT?
- 4. What extra funding has been provided in the 21/22 budget to meet the growing need for interpreters in the NT?
- 5. Do any remote schools have an interpreter training program through VET or otherwise for Senior Secondary students?
