Question: **Is the number of people on the name and shame list increasing or decreasing as of today?**

Answer: The name and shame list was first published on 12 October 2015 and had 335 people on the list.

At 16 June 2016 there were 462 people on the list.

Between 12 October 2015 and 16 June 2016, 135 names were removed from the name and shame list for a variety of reasons, including:

- persons entering into time to pay agreements;
- balances of debts falling below \$10,000;
- fines being paid; and
- removal due to section 66M(2) of the *Fines and Penalties (Recovery) Act*.
