Answer: $\quad$ A total of 42,831 people visited Parliament House in 2003-04. The total for 2002-03 was 39,724.

This number does not include people taking part in tours, functions or visitors to building occupants.

In addition to the totals above, 3,652 people took part in public tours conducted in 2003-04, and in 2002-03 this number was 2,826.
