Answer: The Flora and Fauna Division of DLRM has

several long term biodiversity monitoring programs in parks including Litchfield, Nitmiluk and Kakadu to assess impacts on biodiversity from a range of threats including cane toads. In general, threats

from poor fire regimes and feral cats are more severe than those from cane toads.
