Over the period 1 July 2014 - 31 March 2015 seventy four (74) Community Work Orders (CWO's) were issued. This has resulted in \$0.160 million being recovered which comprises of:

- \$42 700 recovered by defaulters paying their debts through gaol time;
- \$52 800 has been recovered via community work; and
- \$64 500 has been recovered in cash payments.
