**Question: Provide a schedule of the increased attendances of NTIS staff up to date since the Alice Springs NTIS Southern Region Coordinator position was last filled and the attendance for the last 12 months?**

**Answer:**

From July 2011 to June 2012, the following NTIS Head Coaches visited Alice Springs to observe local athletes in training and competition, run training sessions for any NTIS or sport nominated athletes, educate and mentor local coaches, and / or present at coaching courses:

- Mr Duncan McGillivray (rugby league) visited from 3 to 5 September 2011;
- Mr Shane McDermott (cricket) visited from 7 to 9 September 2011; and
- Ms Dianne Brown (netball) visited from 23 to 25 September and 26 to 28 November, 2011.
- Mr Shane McDermott (cricket) visited from 6-11 March 2012;
- Ms Dianne Brown (netball) visited from 2-4 March 2012;
- Mr Brenton Toy (Australian football) visited from 18-20 March 2012; and
- Mr Murray Archibald (rugby union) visited from 20-23 April 2012.

The NTIS Sport Psychology and Athlete Careers and Education Coordinator, Ms Liz Grylls, also visited Alice Springs in November 2011 to meet with the 6 Level 5 scholarship athletes, parents and coaches and to run an information session that was open to the wider Alice Springs sport community.

The NTIS also covered the costs of three Alice Springs based netball athletes to visit Darwin on 23 March 2012 to train with the NTIS Netball Program under the guidance of the National team (the Diamonds) Head Coach, Ms Lisa Alexander.
