The NT Government still have to spend some of its own money to secure these tied grants. How much money does the NT Government have to spend?

Answer:

National Partnership payments under the 2009-2014 Nation Building Program are tied funding towards the National Network and NT Territory Roads.

The NT Government has completed its commitment for any shared funding arrangements under the 2009-2014 Nation Building Program.

One component of the nation building program that is joint funded is the off-network program (Community Beef and Mining Roads program), which is a \$82 million program over the five years from 2009-10 to 2013-14, of which the Australian Government share is \$52 million and the NT Government share is \$30 million. The NT Government has committed and spent its \$30 million contribution. A further component is the heavy vehicle productivity and safety program where the Australian Government has provided \$2.3 million towards projects and the Northern Territory has also committed a similar amount. The projects are complete and funds expended.
