Mr Maley to the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics:

Arnhem Road Works

For the 2021-22 financial year, a total of \$1.75 million was allocated for repairs and maintenance along section of the road between the Arnhem Highway and Central Arnhem Road, including access roads to Ramingining and Maningrida.

In addition, \$11.6 million in capital works was allocated including: upgrade to four crossings (Tomkinson River, Cadell River and two minor waterways); upgrade and seal 3km at Red Lily Lagoon; and seal to 1.2km of Maningrida-Ramingining Road.

Questions:

For ease of reference the three projects are listed as follows;

- a) Arnhem Link Road upgrade of four crossings (Tomkinson River, Cadell River and two minor waterways)
- b) Oenpelli Road upgrade and seal 3km at Red Lily Lagoon
- c) Maningrida Ramingining Road seal 1.2km

1. Has a tender been awarded for these works? If not, why not?

- a) Construction tender was awarded on 13 December 2021.
- b) Design works have been completed and the project will be considered for funding under future programs when approvals have been obtained.
- c) Construction tender was awarded on 25 June 2021.

2. Who was the tender awarded to and what was the price?

- a) Aldebaran Contracting Pty Ltd for \$9.84 million excluding GST.

3. When will these works commence?

- a) Works at Cadell River and one minor waterway commenced mid-September 2022. The works at Tomkinson River and the other minor waterway will commence in 2023, when road access is available following the wet season.

4. What is the time frame for completion of works?

5. What allowance is being made for budget blowouts?

Projects allow for construction contingency to cover variations.
