**Subject:** Transition of shared services from NT Police to DCDD

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### QUESTION

Of the 17 shared services, which services fit within which 3 main categories, and the time frame for them to be delivered, including those services which will go from Police directly to DCDD and not to Fire.

### ANSWER

The 17 shared services and their respective categories are as follows:

1. Services deemed immediately critical and requiring establishment/access outside NT Police within the next 6-months:
  - a. Information and Communication Technology (ICT)
  - b. Human Resources (HR)
  - c. Work Health and Safety (WHS)
  - d. Infrastructure and Facilities Management
  - e. Media and Communications
  - f. Secretariat
  - g. Policy and Strategic Services
  - h. Risk, Audit and Governance
  - i. Legal Services
2. Services deemed requiring establishment/access outside NT Police within the next 12-months:
  - a. College/RTO
  - b. Finance
  - c. Fines and Recovery
  - d. Records Management and Information Management
  - e. Procurement and Supply
  - f. Wellbeing Services
3. Services likely to remain with NT Police and be accessed by NTFES on a fee-for-service basis:
  - a. Fleet
  - b. Joint Emergency Services Communication Centre (JESCC)

As at the date of answering this question, discussions are continuing with NT Police, DCDD and within NTFES with respect to determining exactly where each service will be established. That information will crystallise as the transition continues to progress.
