The number of graduates and apprentices that started with the department in 2007, 2008 and 2009, and how many of them are still with the department, and how many of them are still with the Northern Territory government?

Answer: The number of graduates/apprentices that started with the department in 2007, 2008, and 2009 – 26, including school-based apprentices - 8 in 2007; 15 in 2008; and 3 in 2009 to date. How many of those graduates/apprentices still with their original department? Fourteen, including school-based apprentices - two from 2007, nine from 2008, and three from 2009. How many are still with NTG? Eighteen including school-based apprentices and those still with the NTPFES - three from 2007, 12 from 2008, and three from 2009. I believe that might answer your question.

The number of graduates/apprentices that started with the Department in 2007, 2008, and 2009 –
26, including school-based apprentices:

§ 8 in 2007;
§ 15 in 2008; and
§ 3 in 2009 to date.

How many of those graduates/apprentices still with their original department?

14, including school-based apprentices:

§ 2 from 2007;
§ 9 from 2008; and
§ 3 from 2009.

How many are still with NTG?

18 including school-based apprentices and those still with the NTPFES:

§ 3 from 2007;
§ 12 from 2008; and
§ 3 from 2009.
