- o Litchfield National Park construction of the Wangi Visitor Centre facility  $\$2\ 100$
- o Hidden Valley Motor Sports Complex major upgrade to drainage, sewerage and electrical works across the complex \$1 250
- o Installation of a stinger net in the Darwin region \$1 000
