Question: Could I get a breakdown into three cross ranges, for the thousand houses that were upgraded since August 2016? The range would be from minimum to the maximum, and if we can split that into, say, three equal categories?

Answer: The above question followed on from discussions around completed upgrades during the current Government's term. To 31 March 2019, 1013 upgrades have been completed and are detailed below in three equal \$100 000 categories.
