### Question

#### Staffing

1. How many staff are in Department of Education detailed by:
  - a. Full Time equivalent;
  - b. Permanent Part time contract; and
  - c. Temporary contract.
2. How many staff are ECO 1 level and above detailed by classification level please.
3. How many staff resigned in 2014/15 to date and what is that as a percentage of the agencies total staff?
4. How many staff were made redundant in 2014/15?

### Answer

1. For Pay 26, 2014-15 (17 June 2015) there were:
  - a. **4145 FTE** (full-time equivalent) employees
  - b. **157 FTE** ongoing (permanent) part time employees
  - c. **1396 FTE** fixed period (temporary contract) employees

2. For Pay 26, 2014-15 (17 June 2015), there were 35 FTE employees who were Executive Contract Officer (ECO) level 1 or above, as detailed in the following table.

**Details – Executive Contract Officers**

\*Note that the ECO4 figure includes one acting ECO4 while another is on paid leave.

3. For the financial year 2014-15, the number of resignations was 458 (headcount) or 11.0 per cent of the total FTE of employees in the department (4145 FTE).
4. During financial year 2014-15, 7 employees accepted voluntary retrenchment.
