Darwin Street Art Festival

1. Please advise how much the Government invested in the augmented reality feature?

The App to facilitate the augmented reality cost \$10 500, and the 3D modelling and animations cost a further \$10 000. These funds were included as part of the overall cost of the Darwin Street Art Festival.

2. Why was a Melbourne company used instead of a local ICT business?

There is significant complexity in ensuring the murals trigger the animation, taking into account the light environment, angles and obstructions. This is a specialist capability that is not a specialty of any Northern Territory-based companies.
