Mrs Finocchiaro to the Minister for Health:

**Norrie Report – update**

1. What is the status of the implementation of the recommendations of the Independent Review of Part IIA Orders completed by Dr Peter Norrie (the Norrie Review Report)?
  2. Have any recommendations been rejected and if so which ones and why?
  3. How many deaths have there been in custody for those under Part IIA Orders over the past two years? What were the causes of those deaths?
  4. What is the status of the Forensic Services Review?
  5. Will it be publicly released once finalised?
  6. Who is conducting the Forensic Services Review and how much is it costing?
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- 1 & 2. NT Health will determine the implementation strategy including timeframes following receipt of the report of the Forensic Mental Health Services Review.
3. Two supervised persons died of natural causes while under Part IIA Orders.
4. A draft report will be provided to the Minister for Health in early 2019.

6. An independent consultant, Mr David McGrath is conducting the Review assisted by an independent panel of experts: Dr Ed Heffernan, Professor Leanne Dowse Dr Owen Samuels, and Ms Danielle Nagle. Panel members were identified for their experience and expertise across the areas the Review will consider. Costs for the review are yet to be finalised.
