Mr Higgins for the Minister for Local Government, Housing and Community Development:

**Fence wrapping of housing projects**

- 1. How many housing projects in remote communities currently feature or have featured the “Our Community. Our Future. Our Homes” fence signage or wrap?**

All remote housing works being delivered under the ‘Our Community. Our Future. Our Homes.’ remote housing investment package feature signage or wrap.

- 2. What has been the cost of producing that signage/wrap for remote housing?**

\$18 656 for 2018/19.

- 3. How many metres of signage/wrap have been produced?**

1000 metres

- 4. On average, how long does the signage/wrap stay up at the site?**

The signage is expected to remain in place on site until completion of the works and is re-usable.

- 5. What is the purpose of the signage/wrap in remote communities?**

Provide community residents and visitors of the commitment of the Northern Territory Government’s Remote Engagement and Coordination Strategy investing in addressing overcrowding in the community and is consistent with informing of remote community

participation, reinforcing the community's involvement, collaboration and empowerment of their local decision making outcomes.
