ANSWER

The agency continues to work towards the transition of public housing management to registered Community Housing Providers (CHP). In 2020-21, the agency undertook consultation and issued a discussion paper on the intended transition of public housing management to registered Community Housing Providers. This project will continue in 2021-22. In addition the agency received a submission from Integrated Disability Action to outsource NT Companion Card administration. This will be implemented in 2021-22.

Territory Families, Housing and Communities (the Department) has a total of 1,735 staff members (1,385 FTE). It has adopted the regional boundaries of the Department of the Chief Minister and Cabinet. Services delivered from the Department's Regional Offices include housing services, crisis accommodation services, client and case management services in the areas of family support, child protection, out of home care, carer assessment services, practice leaders and cultural advisors, domestic and family violence prevention, youth outreach and engagement officers, seniors and pensioner concession scheme services.

In 2020-21, there were positive outcomes delivered in each portfolio, particularly in the areas of child safety, early intervention, youth justice and community engagement. Agency achievements are highlighted in the TFHC Annual Report and other published sources such as Australian Institute of Health and Welfare Reports, Report on Government Services and the 2020 Generational Change Impact Report
