Due to the significant administrative effort required to provide a detailed breakdown of advertising and communications costs, the Department of People, Sport and Culture has provided a broad overview of its communications and marketing activities for the period.

The Department of People, Sport and Culture's total expenditure for advertising and communications for the period 1 July 2024 to 31 March 2025 was \$434,464. Due to additional Machinery of Government processes, it is an administrative burden to provide amounts accurately from 24 August 2024.

This expenditure includes expenses such as:

- printing of collateral (for example posters, flyers and banners);
- event costs (for example, venue hire and merchandise);
- advertising fees (for example print, online and social media);
- graphic design materials (for example design of promotional materials or infographics explaining processes and systems to community and stakeholders); and
- some administrative costs (such as subscriptions to media outlets and marketing software).

As a diverse community services agency, the Department of People, Sport and Culture has wide-ranging requirements for advertising and communications. These can be broadly categorised as:

- promoting available grants to the sector and public;
- promoting opportunities for communities to 'have your say';
- hosting annual prestigious awards events for the arts and sports sectors;
- advertising workforce vacancies;
- promoting available programs, events, services, vouchers and concessions to the public; and
- communicating rights and responsibilities to our client base.

Marketing services are provided internally where possible, such as strategy and content development, however graphic design and photography requires outsourcing due to these resources moving to other departments as part of Machinery of Government changes in late 2024. All advertising is booked through the approved Northern Territory Government provider, Atomic 212.

The primary media channel for the Department of People, Sport and Culture’s advertising spend is the NT News, NTG owned social media channels and community radio.

Key marketing and communications expenses included:

- \$8,485 for recruitment marketing and advertising;
- \$20,777 for photography and videography;
- \$91,261 for general marketing and communications; and
- \$313,941 for major events.

Notable marketing and communications activities for the period 24 August to 31 March 2025 included:

- delivery of the Northern Territory Performing Arts Awards;
- promoting what was on at the Araluen Arts Centre;
- promoting programs and services for Library & Archives NT;
- stakeholder eNews to sports and arts sectors;
- promotion of the NT Arts Grants Programs; and
- promotion of Northern Territory Concession and Seniors Recognition Schemes renewals.
