

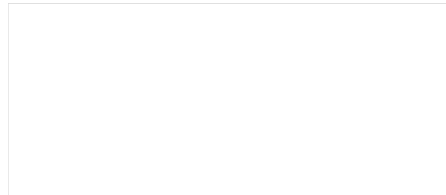

1. Has the Commonwealth government offered an increase or expansion of 11% funding for any of the following programs for 1992-93 -
 - (a) SAAP;
 - (b) CAP;
 - (c) National Women's Health Strategy Program;
 - (d) National Aboriginal Health Strategy Program;
 - (e) Burdekin Funding; and
 - (f) HACC.
2. If the answer to question 1 is yes, has the Northern Territory government taken up that increased offer and will it match it in the required amounts; if not, why not.

ANSWER

1.
 - (a) SAAP - no;
 - (b) CAP - no;
 - (c) Women's Health Strategy - no;
 - (d) Aboriginal Health Strategy - no;
 - (e) Burdekin - no; and
 - (f) HACC - yes, up to 11%.
2. Under the HACC program the NT could initiate a request to increase funds up to 11%. These funds needed to be matched on a 60:40 basis. There was an increase of 2% in funding for 1992-93. Budgetary constraints prevented a greater increase in funding level.
