

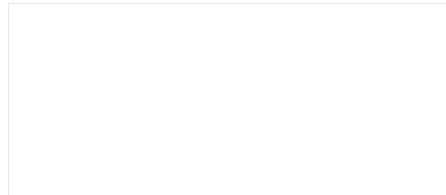

Question : Northern Territory Government Receipts

What were the Northern Territory government receipts in the 1991-92 financial year from stamp duty on share or loan security transactions on the following ventures -

- (a) Darwin Sheraton;
- (b) Alice Springs Sheraton;
- (c) Yulara Resort;
- (d) Dalway Pty Ltd;
- (e) Modular Medical Products; and
- (f) other ventures in which the Northern Territory government has or had equity.

ANSWER

Actual information about duty paid on loans or purchases by non-government entities is confidential to those entities. The Crown as such does not pay duty on transactions when it is the borrower or transferee.

The Commissioner of Taxes is the only person in a position to know actual receipts of stamp duty and he is prohibited by law from disclosing information relevant to individual taxpayers obtained as a consequence of performing his duty under the Act.
